

## CASSI'S CORNER

GNMC wrapped up another exciting year. We delivered \$4.6 million worth of medical services and prescriptions to our nearly 700 patients in 2023. Our 103 volunteers donated 9,875+ hours of service providing 3,626 total medical visits, 407 on-site lab tests, and 16,573 prescriptions provided at no charge. We provided 872 specialty care visits through referrals and over 2,900 labs and imaging tests. We also invested in the future of health-care by training 16 future nurses, one Community Health Worker, and 4 college interns.

The big news last year was our addition of transportation through our new partnership with Lowcountry Outreach, as well as our 22% growth in referrals to specialty care. As we improve our screening processes to include social determinants of health, we continue to reach out into the community to find partners to support those needs. We are grateful to have so many willing collaborators in the Lowcountry.

We continue to be so fortunate in our ability to recruit amazing talent to support our mission. Dr. Kessel and I welcomed Dr. David Baehren to our staff in January. Since Dr. Kessel shifted to our Advisory Council. Dr. Baehren now serves as the Medical Director of GNMC. He has a strong background in Emergency Medicine, and is also a published author. A fun fact and my favorite part of the story of recruiting Dr. Baehren is how and where we found him. Our paths first crossed while he was being a Good Neighbor, volunteering with his church mission group, LOVE BEAUFORT, from The Parish Church of St. Helena, on a lawn maintenance project. Once again, GNMC's Medical Director is not only a well respected physician, but one with a heart for service. We are truly blessed!

# **GRANT NEWS**

The conclusion of the year always marks a pivotal time for grant and partner funding, and this year has been no exception. We are privileged to continue our partnerships with esteemed organizations such as AmVets Post 70 Ladies, Bargain Box, Coastal Community Foundation – Southern Lowcountry Grant, First Presbyterian Church, Friends of Callawassie Island, Old Village Association, Owenoke Foundation, Pledge the Pink Foundation, and St. Peter's Catholic Church.

GNMC is grateful for the ongoing grant support from the **Pledge the Pink Foundation.** For the first time GNMC received funding from a Pledge the Pink team (**Nathalie Howell and the Wandering Warriors**). Teams surpassing \$5,000 in fundraising can allocate 75% of the funds raised to the non-profit of their choice. We are so appreciative to be their chosen non-profit!



Furthermore, we are pleased to welcome new supporters into our network, including **Lighthouse Christian Church, Rotary Club of the Lowcountry,** and **Tidal Creek Fellowship**.

As we stepped into the new year, GNMC reaffirmed its commitment to ongoing collaborations with **Beaufort County Human Services Alliance**, **State of SC DHHS Contract**, and **St. Mark's Episcopal Church**. Additionally, we are thrilled to forge new alliances with partners such as **Charter One Realty** and **Laughing Acres Family Foundation**.

In January, GNMC hosted the **Women in Philan- thropy** Grants in Action Team for a tour of the clinic



and lunch. We had so much fun sharing our mission and providing stories and insight into our critical work in Beaufort. Thank you for taking the time to visit us and see first-hand the impact of your generous support.

We also had the privilege of presenting at the **2024 Beaufort Senior Leadership Class**, followed by a tour of our clinic to further expand on the services we offer.

GNMC staff and volunteer board members attended the **South Carolina Free Clinic Association** (SCFCA) Conference in Greenville, SC. This experience provided opportunities to connect with Free Clinic Leaders and stakeholders from across the state.

GNMC was recognized for our **AmeriCorps** Community Health Worker program, as we showed a 45% improvement in health outcomes and positive change in health behaviors of enrolled clients in 2023! GNMC was also asked to present on two of our partnerships that allow us to provide unique services to our patients: transportation assistance and transitioning patients to other primary care when they are no longer eligible for our services. GNMC was excited to learn more about the new **Roadmap to Health Equity** program, sponsored by **NAFC**, **Americares and Loyola University**. GNMC agreed to be an "early adopter" in gathering important data as an effort to support this initiative being driven by BCBS and the SCFCA. We look forward to sharing the positive outcomes.
